The Family Loan Partnership provides interest free-loans to families in Northern Virginia making the transition from Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (**TANF**) to independence. Qualified applicants receive up to \$3,000 and will be expected to pay the loan back within 24 months. The two main criteria for applicant eligibility is:

- 1) TANF or TANF transitional (must have received a TANF check within the past 12 months).
- 2) Must be employed for at least 90 days.

PWC Office of Housing and Community Development- 703-792-7530

Office is responsible for administering County Housing Programs and initiatives such as Community Development and Rehabilitation for owner-occupied units or first time home buyers; **Foreclosure Rehabilitation Acquisition Program (FRAP)** provides financial counseling, home ownership education, deferred loans for down-payment, closing costs, or rehabilitation for select areas within PWC and for those who have obtained financing; **Homeownership Assistance Program (HAP)** provides financial counseling, education, and deferred loans for down-payment, closing costs or energy efficiency improvements for the property being purchased.
